



Biodiversity Corner

II-Berwieq perennial plant typically growing in the garigue was introduced on College Campus four years ago. Anyone walking in the countryside right now will notice the conspicuous long stalks with white/ pinkish flowers covering the garigue. It survives the harsh summer season as dormant roots underground (hence referred to as a geophyte). Noticable in summer would be the dry asphodel stalks which are often covered with white (dormant) snails escaping the extremely hot soil surfaces.
