

Eyeing the future... opportunities

The Ministry for Health in Malta has acquired European Union Funds in order to sponsor Maltese trainees to follow a three(3)-year course at a University abroad leading to a Bachelors Degree in Optometry or a Bachelors in Orthoptics. These funds will provide full sponsorship for the trainees with paid tuition, subsistence allowance for accommodation and daily living expenses, travel expenses as well as being employed by the Ministry for Health and receiving a trainee salary during the three(3)-year course, and receiving employment following successful completion of the course.



Selected students will start in September 2019. The students will need to be accepted by the selected universities and need to meet the necessary criteria, as well as undergo an interview with a Selection Board.

JC Wellbeing and Sports Festival




The College organised the JC Wellbeing and Sports Festival between the 11 and 15 March. The staff and students involved themselves in the activities organised.
















The Sovereign Art Foundation
