


Sustainable Mobility Project


From the Euro-Centre...

InterACT for Inclusion Erasmus + Youth Exchange Project

A week of intercultural dialogue took place at Junior College between 28 January and 1 February. As part of the Erasmus+ Youth Exchange Project "InterACT for Inclusion", the College hosted youths from Belgium, Finland and Germany, who along with the Maltese group, took part in a week of activities focused on active-lifestyle, outdoor sports, inclusion, tolerance and intercultural education.

Through various non-formal activities, and workshops dedicated to the values of tolerance, physical activity and alternative healthy eating, the participants worked in international teams, discussed, exercised, tried a healthier eating approach, and engaged in various social activities which allowed them to fully experience diversity.
